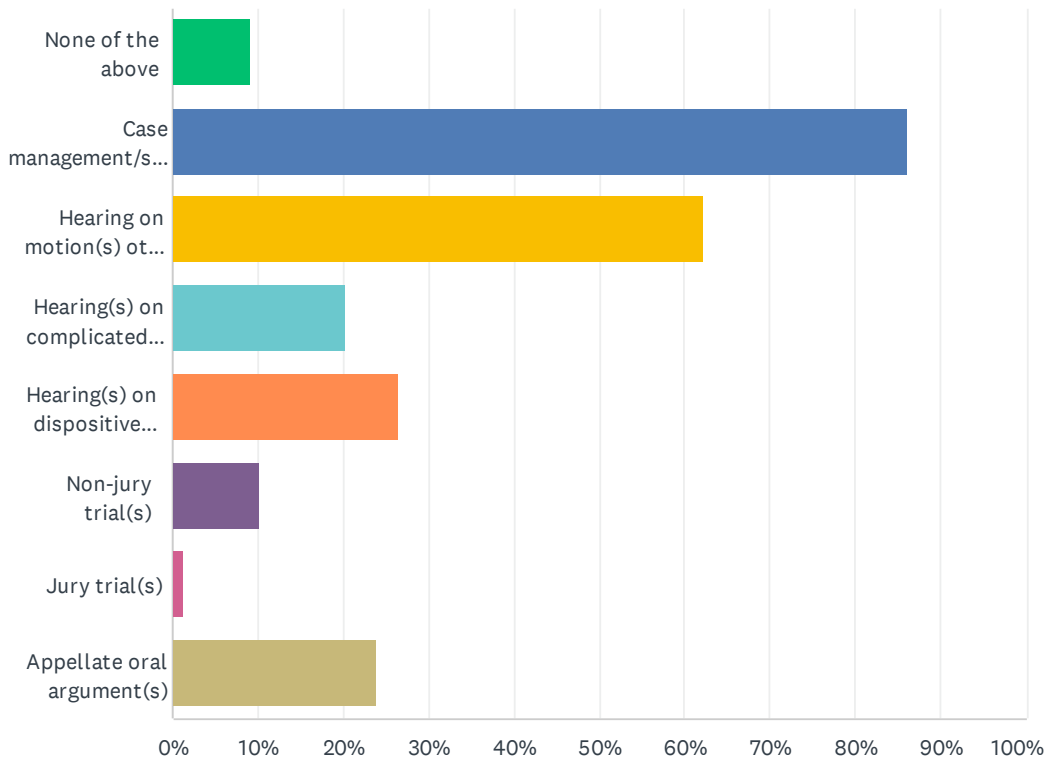


# Q1 Which type of court proceedings have you been involved with while using remote video technology? (Select all that apply)

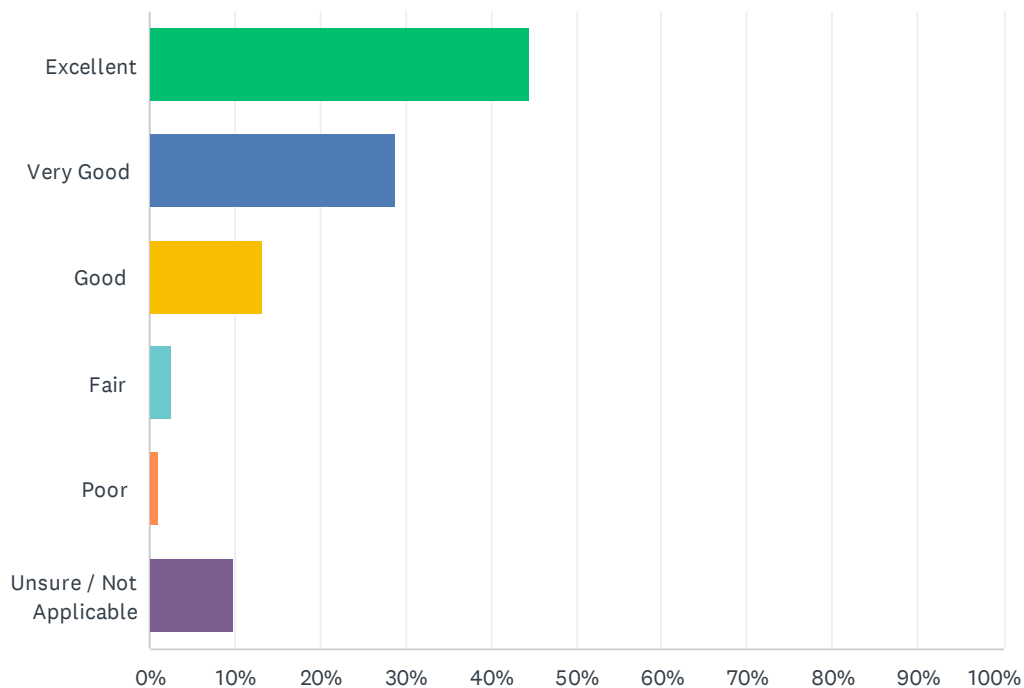

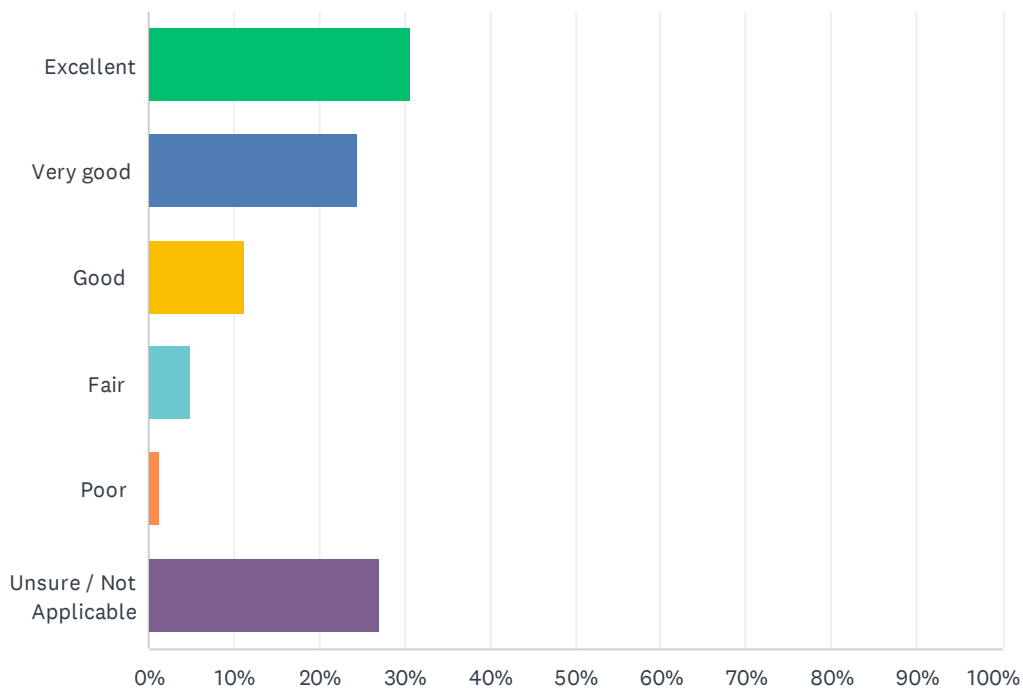

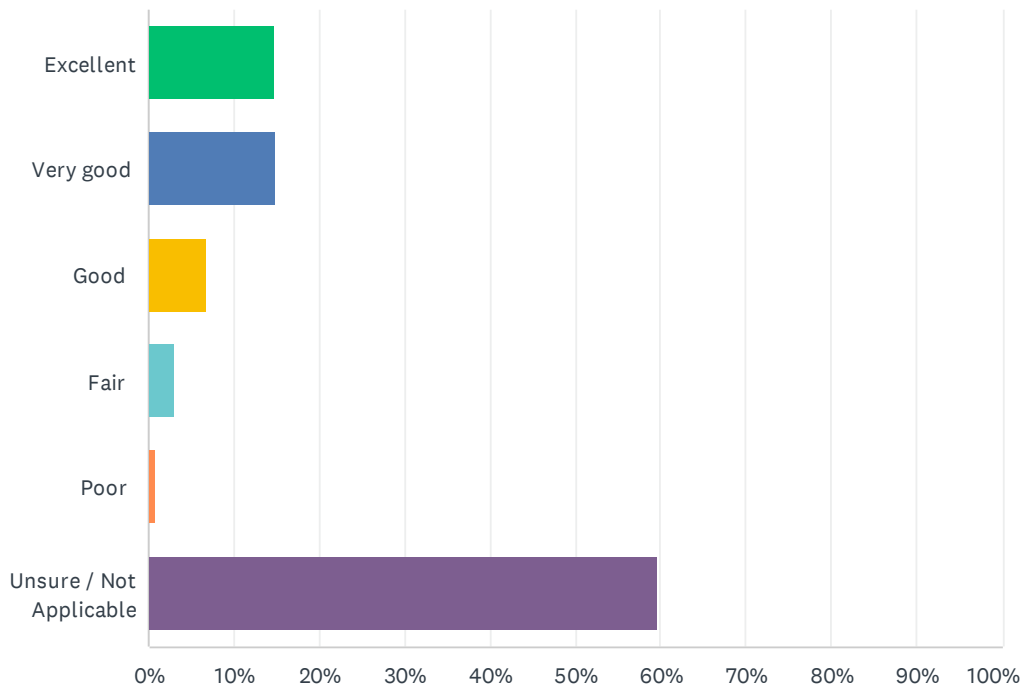

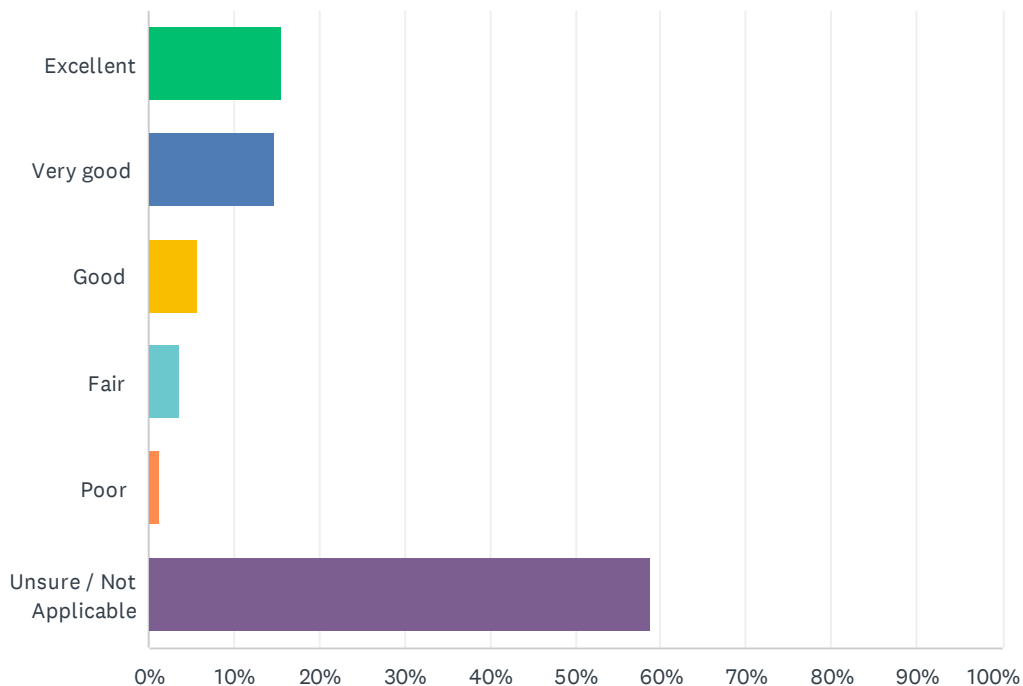

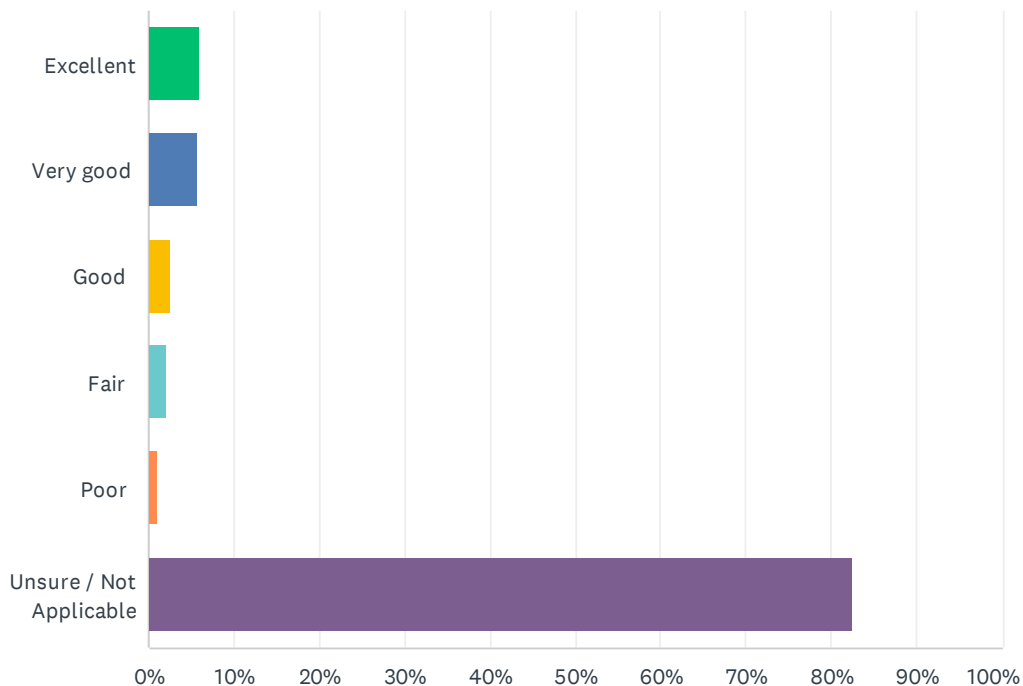

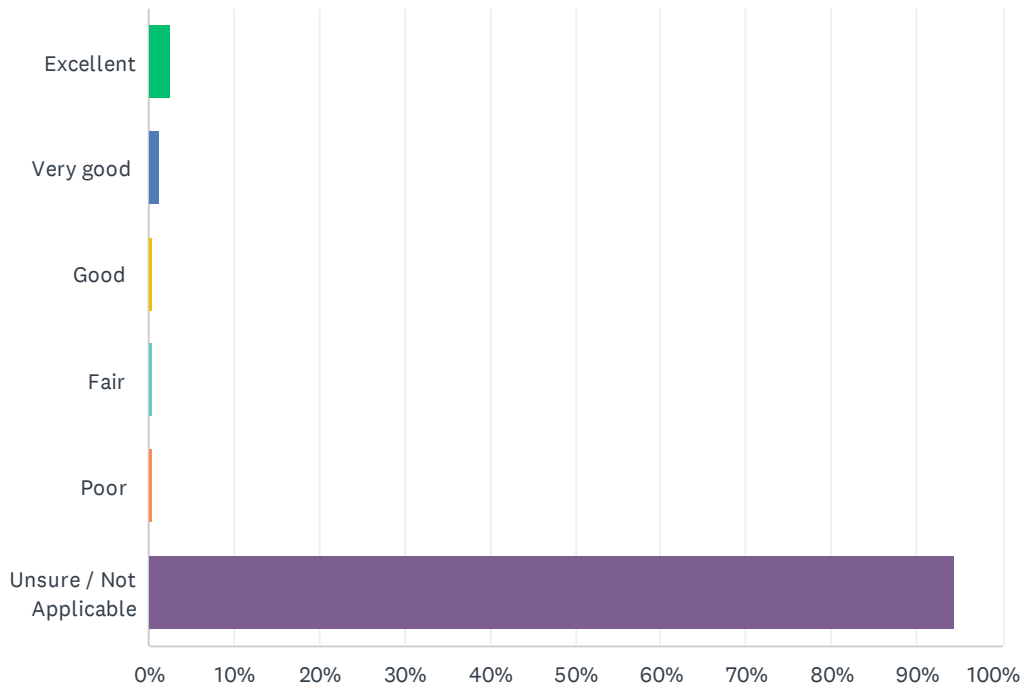

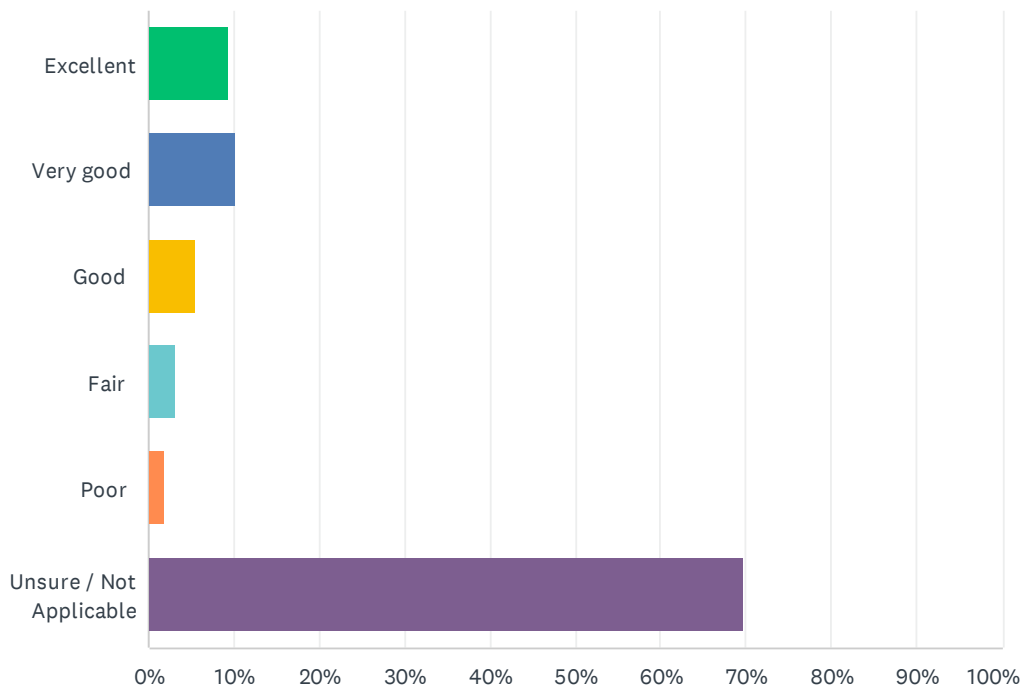

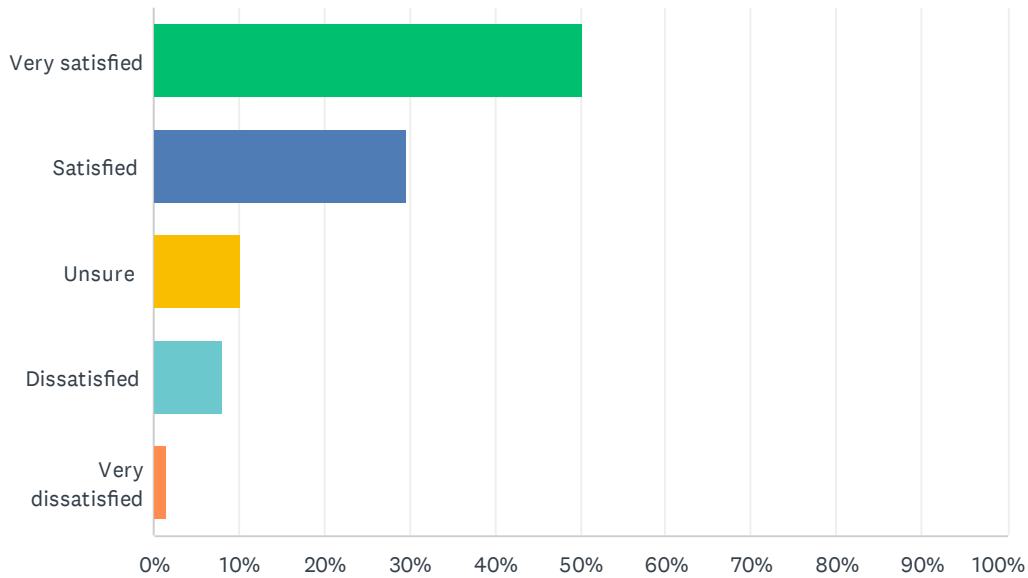

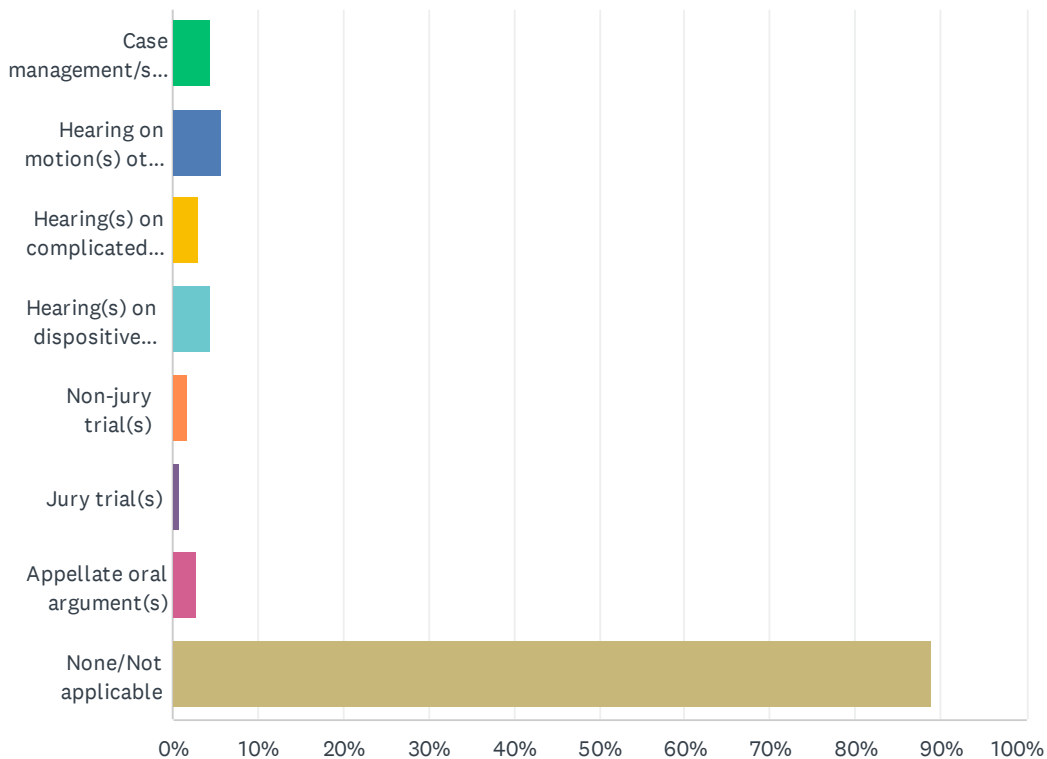

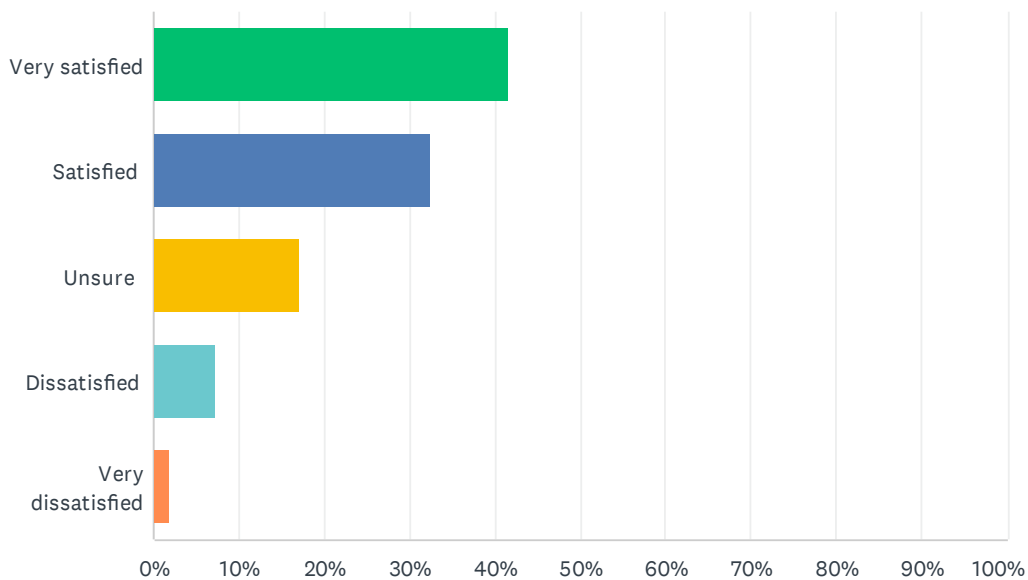

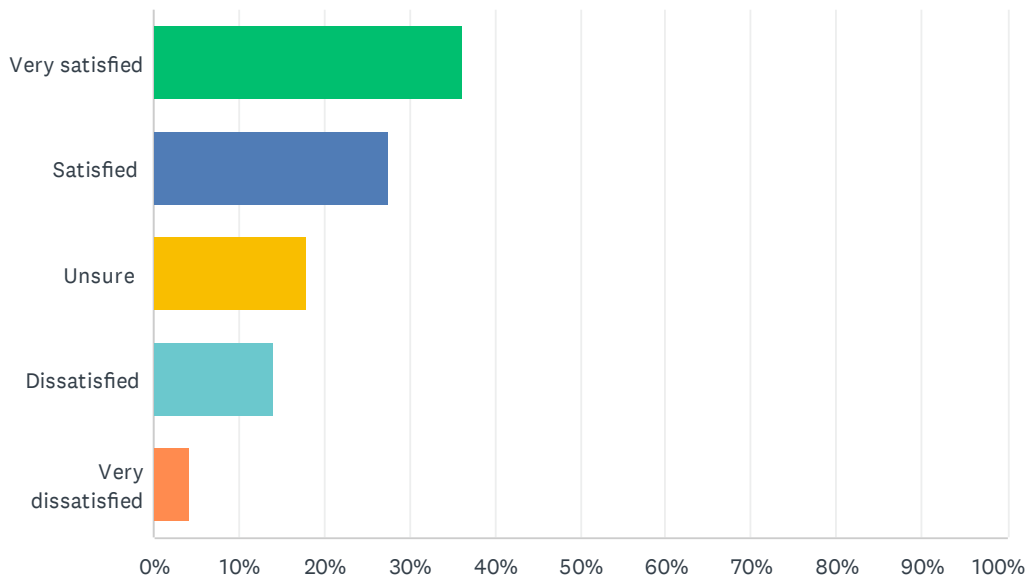

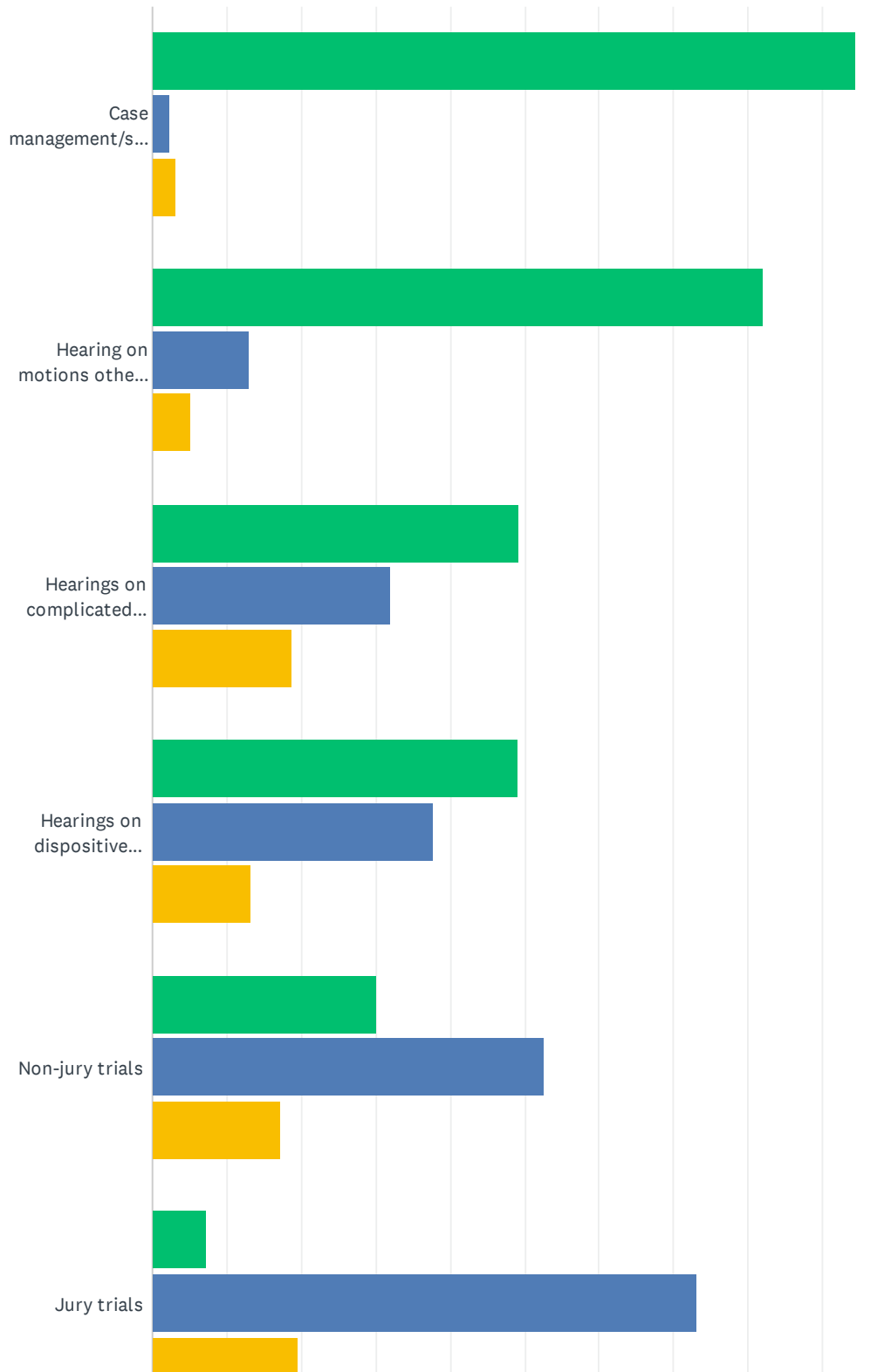

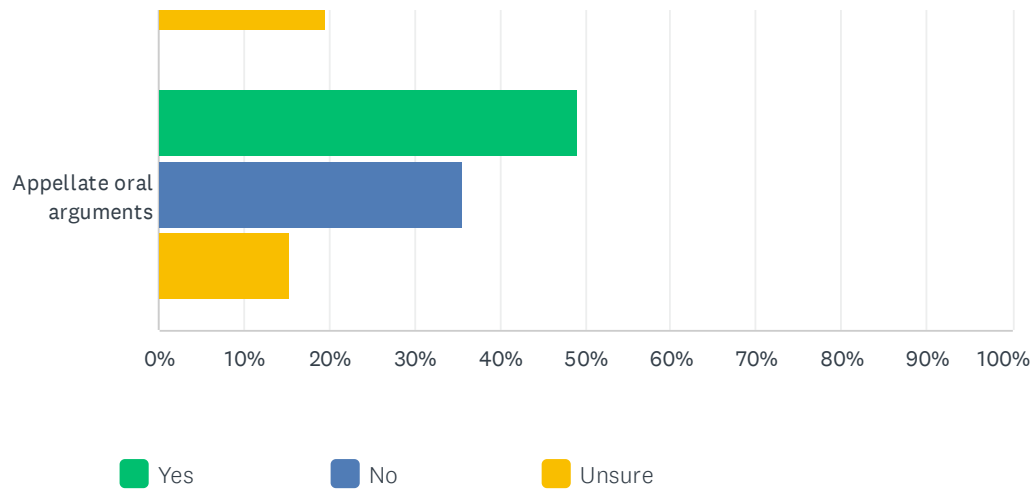

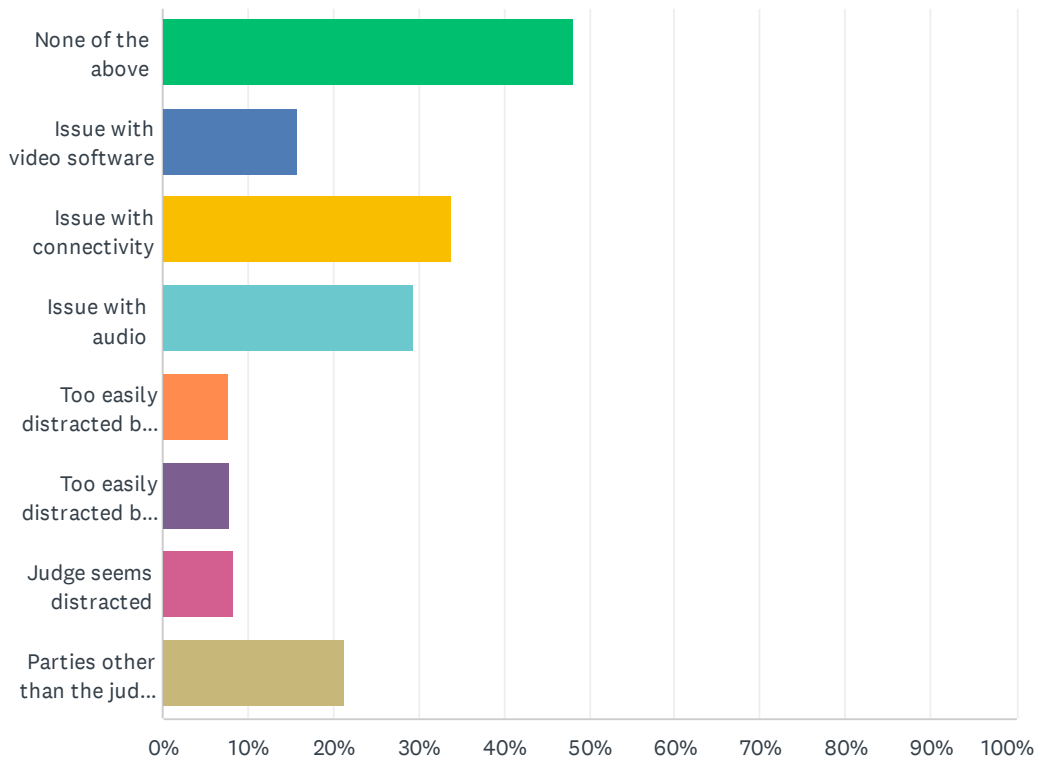
